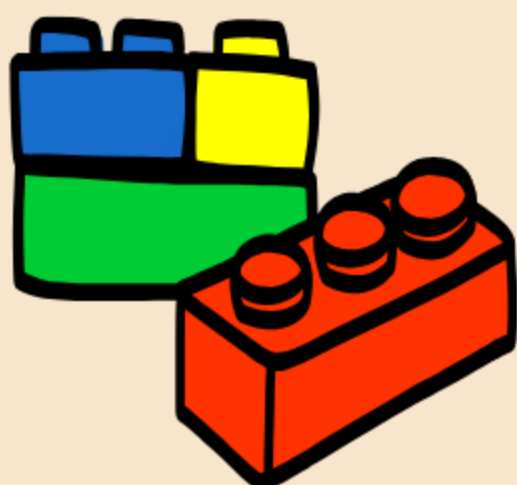
WHERE?

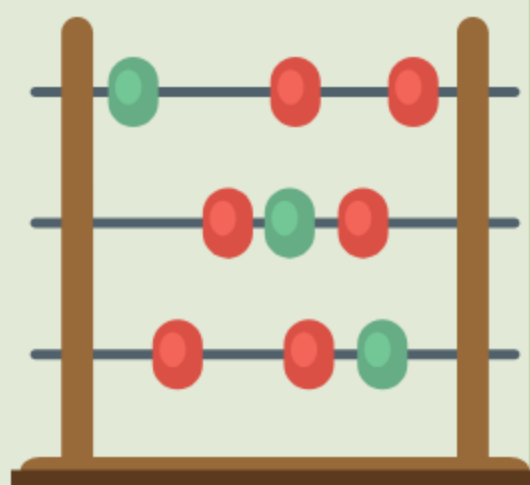
WHO?
